


Scripture Reading – 1 Timothy 4


- 13 Till I come, give attention to reading, to exhortation, to doctrine.

- 16 Take heed to yourself and to the doctrine. Continue in them, for in doing this you will save both yourself and those who hear you.








"Apply thyself wholly to the text. Apply the text wholly to thyself."




- "Study to show **thyself** approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth" (2 Tim. 2:15).
- The word "study" means, "to use speed, i.e. to make effort, be prompt or earnest:--do (give) diligence, (forward), endeavor, labor" (Strong's).


• 1 Timothy 5:22 ends with the words: "Keep thyself pure."




- "Take heed unto thyself, and unto the doctrine; continue in them: for in doing this thou shalt both save thyself, and them that hear thee" (1 Tim. 4:16).
- "Till I come, give attendance to reading, to exhortation, to doctrine. Meditate upon these things; give **thyself** wholly to them; that thy profiting may appear to all" (1 Tim. 4:13-15).



• Jesus said, "Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. This is the first and great commandment. And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself. On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets" (Matt. 22:37-39).




• "Know ye not, that to whom ye yield yourselves servants to obey, his servants ye are to whom ye obey; whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness? But God be thanked, that ye were the servants of sin, but ye have obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine which was delivered you. Being then made free from sin, ye became the servants of righteousness" (Rom. 6:16-18).




- Therefore, after we have been baptized for the remission of sins (Acts 2:38), and raised to "walk in newness of life" (Rom. 6:3-4), we are God's servants (slaves of God).
- Romans 12:1 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. 2 And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

- 1 Peter 2:5 you also, as living stones, are being built up a spiritual house, a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.
- **Hebrews 13:15** Therefore by Him let us continually offer the sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of our lips, giving thanks to His name.


Realize Who Our Judge Is

Realize Who Our Judge Is


• "...God shall judge the secrets of men by Jesus Christ according to my gospel" (Rom. 2:16).

• John 12:48 He who rejects Me, and does not receive My words, has that which judges him—the word that I have spoken will judge him in the last day.




Realize The Great Importance Of Our Soul




Realize The Great Importance Of Our Soul


- In order for souls to be saved, Jesus Christ, the Son of God came to this earth, lived upon this earth, died on the cross, and shed His blood
 - Matthew 26:28 For this is My blood of the new covenant, which is shed for many for the remission of sins.




- "Then shall the dust return to the earth as it was: and the spirit shall return unto God who gave it" (Ecc. 12:7).




- Ultimately, as we stand before Christ in Judgment, there will be two destinies for souls.







